


Locating Property APN Numbers

Step One: Open Map Viewer: <http://maps.co.kern.ca.us/gvs2.2.1/Viewer.html?Viewer=KernGISPubS>

Step Two: Select “Search” tab at top.




Step Four: Search for Parcel Address. *Type Street number, then Street name.*



A. Type Street number first.

B. Type Street name second.

Step Five: Search for Parcel APN. *Use eight (8) digits, with no dashes.*



Step Six: Map should zoom to the parcel at that address or APN. Then click on the Parcel Number in the lefthand Table of Contents, or select the Identity tool at the top center to obtain information for any visible parcel in the map.

A. Click on the parcel number in the lefthand Table of Contents.

B. Or select the Identity tool at the top center.



Step Six: Once you click on the Identity or Parcel Number, the Parcel Detail window will pop-up providing the parcel information.
